## Did You Know?

- > The school district turned down \$35M to renovate the current high school in favor of receiving \$9M to build a new high school.
- ➤ The district has written a letter to the legislature asking for more money for building improvements, pool upgrades, and assistance with staff pay. This is despite having more money than ever before, passing a \$21.4M levy, and giving district employees a pay increase averaging 20% across the board.
- The letter also asks the legislature to repeal the current supermajority law requiring 60% to pass bonds to 50% plus one due to failing bond issues for several years. This is despite having 38% of kids on free and reduced lunches and a median income in the district \$4000 below the surrounding communities.
- There's a widespread use of personal cell phones by administrators to bypass public records request?
- > The ratio of teachers to administer is at an all-time high?

- ➤ Port Orchard and Kitsap County only grew by less than 1% last year. Does this justify a new high school when enrollment is on a decline. The school district had 9660 students in 2017 and 9661 in 2019.
- There is a widespread process of back dating special education forms and signing for meetings that were not attended to get more money?
- > The teachers union wrote "F" this community" on their Facebook page the morning after the bond failed last year?
