Basic Horse and Barn Safety Sample Lesson Plan

- Look at your surroundings/paddock/ground/look around
- Fight/flight / nervous tension / pressure / predator/prey
- Approaching your horse/ 45 degree angle
- Using your voice/speaking / let them know your coming
- About your horses ears
- Where to stand / shoulder / legs / horses back-end
- Normal Voice / speaking to your horse
- Horse's feet
- Horse's back-end / + 12 better 15 feet away
- Safety equipment (helmet ASTM/SEI approved, paddock or riding boots, no loose clothing, riding gloves, pants, no hiking boots, no sandals, no open toe shoes.)
