Consider that Kitsap County Board of Commissioners (BBC) who manages a proposed budget of \$394,000,000 (2020) for all of the 266,550 citizens in Kitsap County are having no problems allowing the public to make online comments using ZOOM during open Kitsap County Board of Commissioner's meetings.

Contrast this with South Kitsap School District's handling of open public meetings.

South Kitsap School District has a proposed budget of approximately \$130,000,000 (2020) with only 74,267 citizens they are responsible to keep informed and serve. If the BCC can manage to hold open Zoom meetings and let community members comment, why it is so hard for SKSD to do the same? Why is SKSD continuing to limp along on their proverbial "left foot" on holding truly open public meetings? The invitation to send in your email to a general mailbox is not cutting it. SKSD again FAILS on issues of openness, transparency, trust and confidence building within our South Kitsap community.
