Summary

For the February 9th, 2021 special election:

There are 60 school measures in total from 50 school districts from 17 counties.

54 measures are advertised as replacement or renewal levies.

5 measures are advertised as capital levies without the words replacement or renewal in their titles.

1 measure is a redistricting authorization measure and is not a levy.

36 of the replacement advertised levies involve an increase in the amount over the previous levy ranging from 3% to 115% more.

10 of the replacement advertised levies are the exact same in amount as the previous levy.

8 of the replacement advertised levies are lower in amount compared to the previous levy.

4 of the replacement advertised levies have shorter durations (fewer years) than their previous levy.

7 of the replacement advertised levies have longer durations (more years) than their previous levy.

42 measures have the words 'Educational Programs and Operations' in their titles.

3 measures have the word 'Enrichment' instead of EP&O in their titles.

1 measure has the words 'Maintenance and Operations' in its title.







Methodology

An ongoing analysis of Washington State's public k-12 schools.

were set to the same values as the Total District Levy AV Growth Rates. The effect of this assumption is that the obligated proportion of the levy for the example property remains constant for each year in the analysis. The Total District Levy AVs were calculated from the levy amounts and levy estimates obtained from the sample ballots.


