

- 1. Use a stronger whip.
- 2. Change riders.
- 3. Appoint a committee to study the horse.
- 4. Lower the standards so that dead horses can be included.
- 6. Reclassify the dead horse as impaired
- 7. Hire outside contractors to continue to ride the dead horse.
- 8. Harness other dead horses together to reduce costs.
- 9. Run a Bond and a Capital levy.
- 10. Perform additional training on how to ride a dead horse.
- 11. Appoint another committee to study the dead horse's performance.
- 10. Perform additional studies to see if lighter riders would improve performance.
- 11. Declare the dead horse needs no food, costs less, lowers overhead, improves budget.
- 12. Rewrite expected performance standards and requirements for all dead horses.
