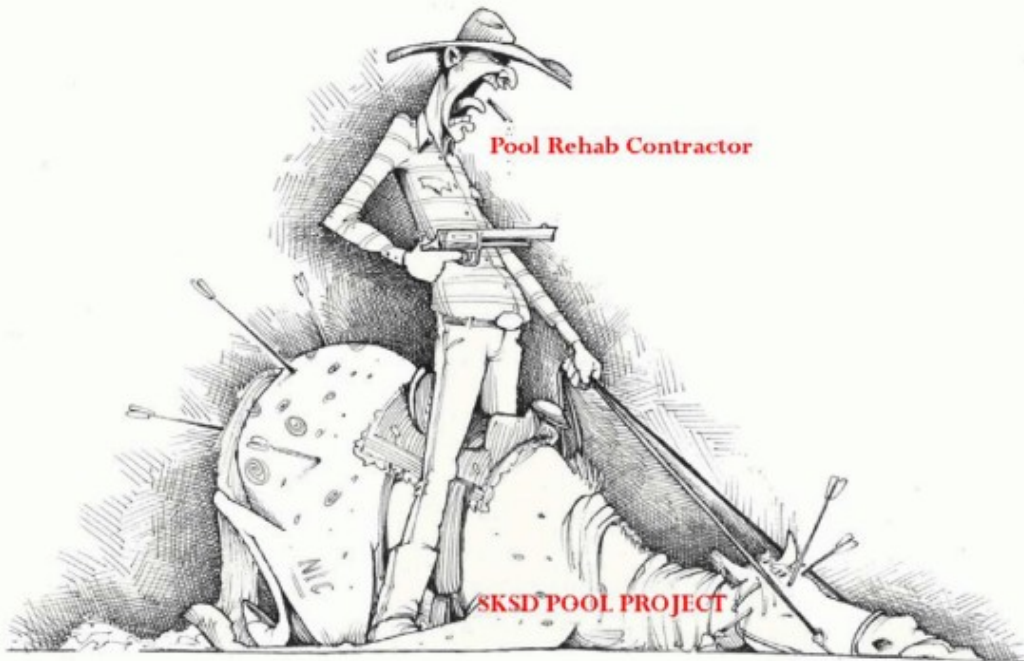


TWELVE WAYS TO REVIVE A DEAD HORSE



1. Use a stronger whip.
2. Change riders.
3. Appoint a committee to study the horse.
4. Lower the standards so that dead horses can be included.
6. Reclassify the dead horse as impaired
7. Hire outside contractors to continue to ride the dead horse.
8. Harness other dead horses together to reduce costs.
9. Run a Bond and a Capital levy.
10. Perform additional training on how to ride a dead horse.
11. Appoint another committee to study the dead horse's performance.
10. Perform additional studies to see if lighter riders would improve performance.
11. Declare the dead horse needs no food, costs less, lowers overhead, improves budget.
12. Rewrite expected performance standards and requirements for all dead horses.
