EX PARTE DENIAL ORDER –
ANTIHARASSMENT

Clerk's Action Required – ¶6

- **REQUEST**. This Matter is before the Court because petitioner requests a protection order against respondent.
- 2. NO HEARING HELD. The Court denies the request without a hearing.
- **FINDINGS**. The Court finds
 - A. <u>Evidence</u>. Petitioner supports their account of events with items filed with the Court.
 - **B.** Insufficient Evidence For Any Type Of Protection Order. The Petition for Protection Order does not contain prima facie allegations that could support the issuance of any type of protection order this Court has authority to issue. Additionally, the petition does not list a specific incident and approximate date of behavior that would support an antiharassment, domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking protection order as defined in RCW 7.105.100.
 - C. Other Findings.

4. ORDER(S). The Court orders that -

- A. <u>Petition Denied</u>. For the reasons discussed in section 3, the *Petition for Protection Order* does not contain prima facie allegations that could support the issuance of any type of protection order this Court has authority to issue. The *Petition for Protection Order* is denied pursuant to RCW 7.105.305(3).
- **Amended Petition Permitted**. Petitioner may file an amended petition within 14 days of the date of this Order. If an amended petition is filed, the Court will thereafter determine whether the amended petition contains prima facie allegations to support the issuance of any type of protection order this Court has authority to issue (per RCW 7.105.305(5)).

- C. <u>Weapons Order Denied</u>. An *Order To Surrender And Prohibit Weapons* is denied because the requirements of RCW 9.41.800 are not met.
- 5. No COURT DATE SCHEDULED. No further court hearings are scheduled in this case.
- **6. CLERK'S ACTION.** The clerk shall provide a copy of this Order to the parties.
